Through the **Supporting New Americans in the Long-Term Care Workforce*** program, you can receive money to take certified nursing assistant (CNA) courses, pay for testing, and continue your nursing education beyond the CNA certification.

This program is offered through a partnership between Healthy Community Initiative, the NCCC, and the Community Action Center.

NCCC support includes:

- Help finding and enrolling in CNA programs
- Coverage of CNA tuition and additional tuition support
- Testing fee support
- Tutoring support while taking classes
- Additional support for transportation and housing while in school
- Navigating employment needs (like buying scrubs)
- Connections to employment in the long-term care industry

Community Action Center support includes:

- Food access
- Housing assistance
- Clothing assistance

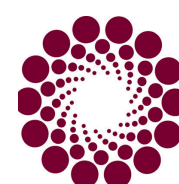
